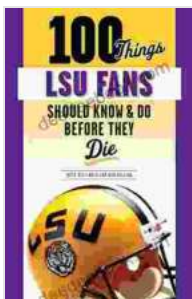


# 100 Things LSU Fans Should Know & Do Before They Die: A Bucket List for the Die-Hard Tiger Faithful

### 16. Attend an LSU gymnastics meet

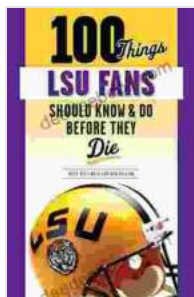
LSU gymnastics is one of the most popular sports on campus. Attend a meet at the Pete Maravich Assembly Center and cheer on the Tigers.

LSU golf is one of the best programs in the country

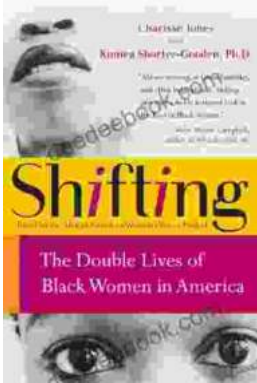

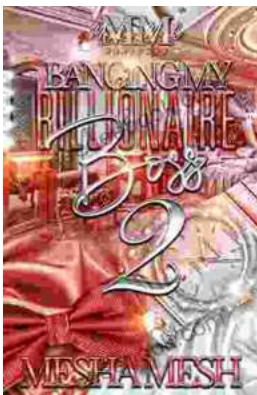
