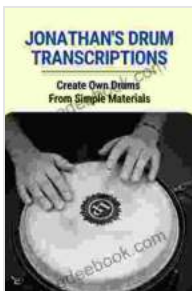

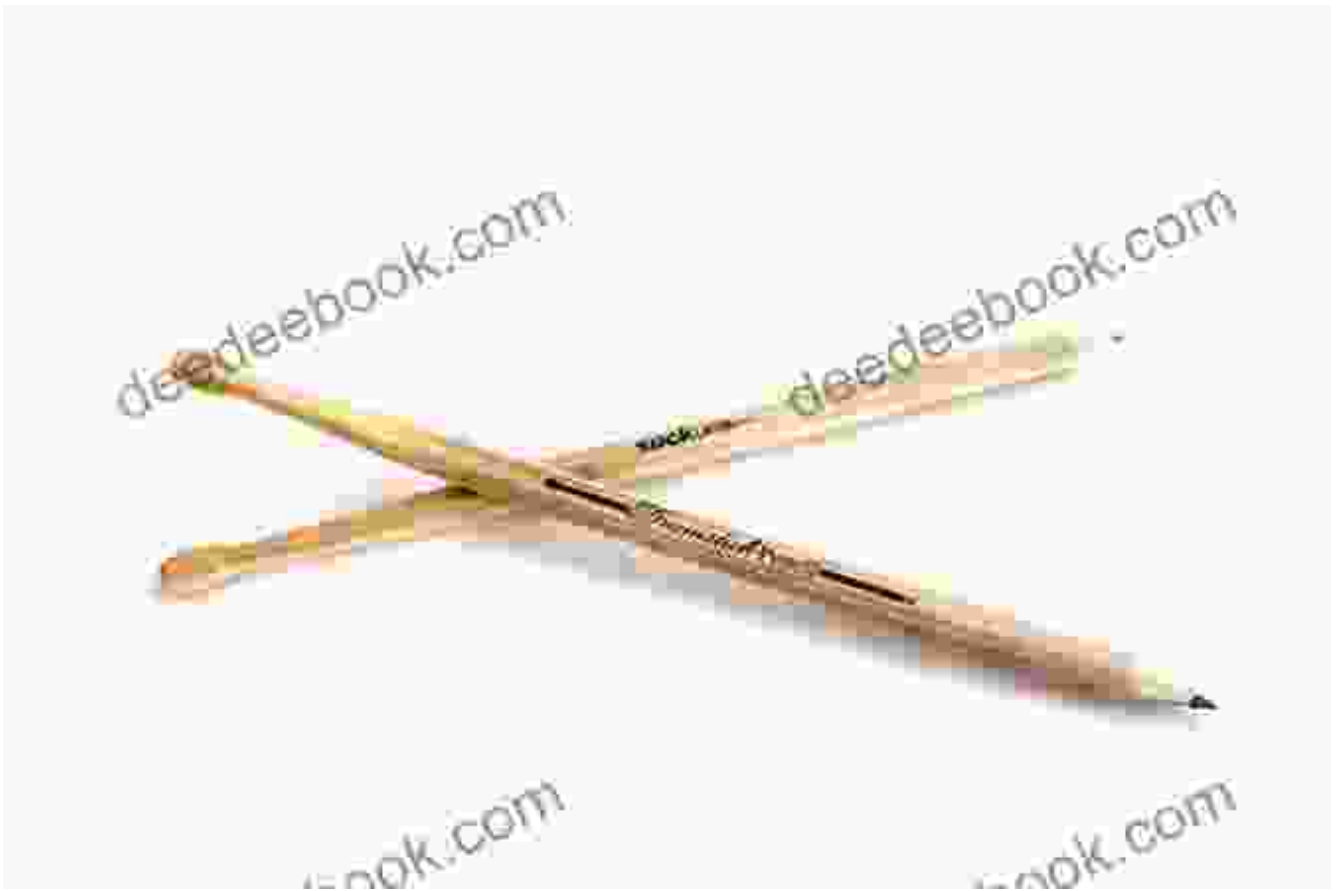

5. Play Your Drum

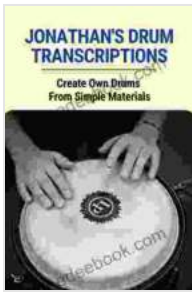

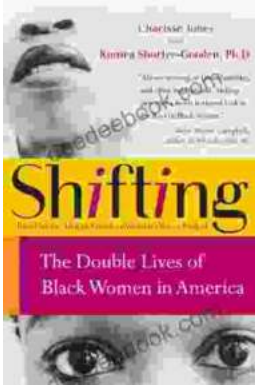

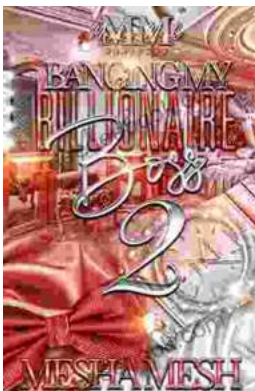
