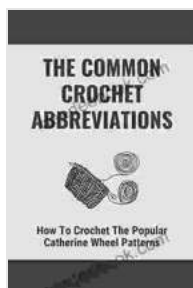

- Worsted weight yarn in two colors
- Crochet hook size H (5.00 mm)
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

1. **Chain 4.**
2. **Slip stitch into the first chain from the hook.**
3. **Chain 3 (counts as a double crochet).**
4. **Double crochet into the same stitch.**
5. **Chain 1.**
6. **Double crochet into the same stitch.**
7. **Chain 1.**
8. **Double crochet into the next stitch.**
9. **Chain 1.**
10. **Slip stitch into the first double crochet.**
11. **Fasten off.**

Repeat steps 1-11 to create the desired length of chain.

12. **Join the ends of the chain with a slip stitch.**
13. **Chain 4.**
14. **Double crochet into the next stitch.**

15. **Chain 1.**
16. **Double crochet into the same stitch.**
17. **Chain 1.**
18. **Double crochet into the next stitch.**
19. **Chain 1.**
20. **Slip stitch into the first double crochet.**
21. **Fasten off.**

Repeat steps 13-21 to create the desired width of the blanket.

22. **To change colors, fasten off the current color and attach the new color to the next stitch.**
23. **Continue crocheting in the new color following the same pattern.**

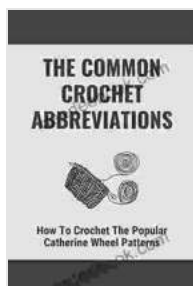
