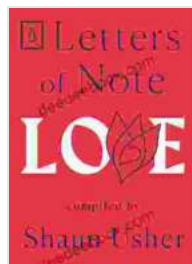

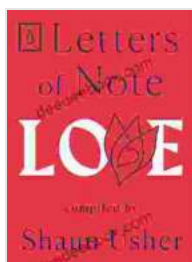
have not been taking care of myself. I am determined to get better, and I am going to start by writing to you more often.

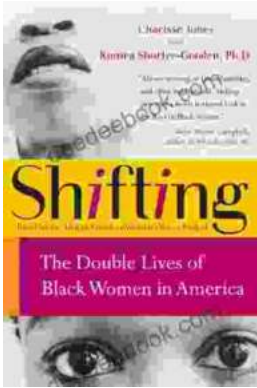

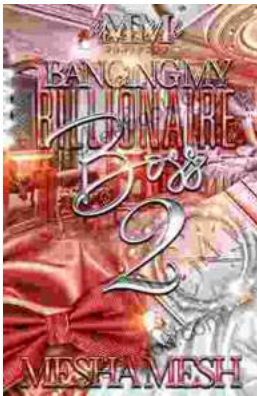
