
Main Bhi Chowkidar : (Loss Of Truth)



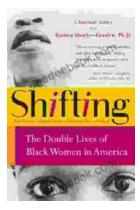
