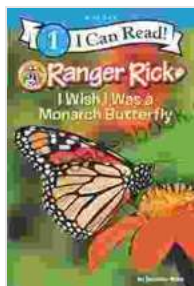

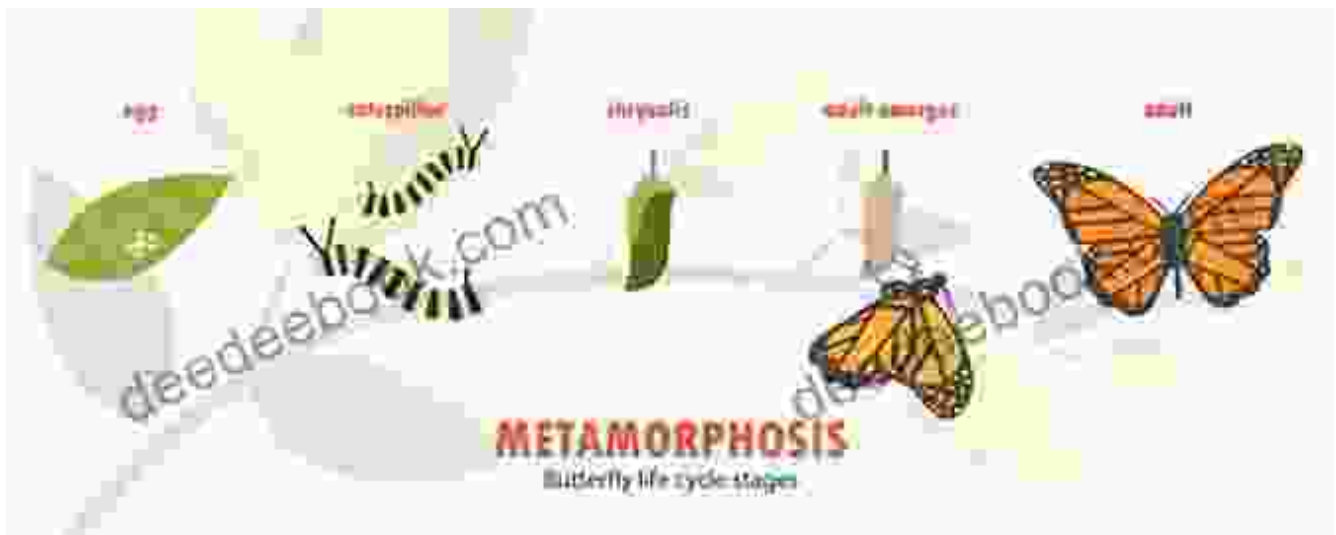
A Caterpillar's Dream
